Top 100 Signature Dish Award:

Panfried Foie Gras – Renounced as one of France's delicacies, foie gras - fattened liver of a goose or duck, is a pleasing accommodation of buttery tangs. Served with a dash of brandied sweet cherry sauce, morsels of this succulent pan fried foie gras make a delightful starter with some crusty bread and sweet wine.

Confit de Canard – This authentic dish originated from southwest of the country and remains a cuisine luxury preserved till today. Tenderised in a bath of silky fats, the duck, originated from France, is cooked for over an hour where the suety broth enhances the rich and gamy flavours of the dark flesh. Bite-sized potato chunks complete this dish with a complimenting touch.

Specialties: Le Troquet boosts a menu of diverse delicacies from the land of France, where the favourites are true blue fare of the country. The *Soupe au poisson* is a special homemade fish soup available only on Fridays and the weekends. Delicacies - with food as luscious as their names - like *Beef Stew in Red Wine Sauce*, *Fresh Grilled Salmon with French Provençale Herbs*, *Ribeye Steak with Blue Cheese* and *Chaucuterie Platter* comprising of *Goose Rillettes*, *Parma Ham* and *Smoked Duck Breast* served with *Mesclun Salad* can satisfy even the most hard-to-please diners. Special desserts such as caramelised cream custard *Crème Brulée*, and cream-filled *Profiterolles* smothered with chocolate sauce and a very pampering *Charlotte aux pommes* made of cooked apples and vanilla ice-cream with a dash of *Jamaican rum* complete meals with the sweetest touch.

Ambience: An endearing café set through a light airy atmosphere with wooden bar counters and plant-fringed seating outdoors. A streak of sophistication runs amid simplicity, this restaurant houses diners comfortably for tasty fills and a French experience.

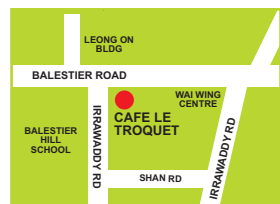
